# A.Fazekash: 'Edīte'

Muskat Voskovej x Aljoshenkin + Pearl of Szaba

Sugar 15-20, vinifera taste, wood hardens well. Ripens in August.



# A.Fazekash: 'Gauja'

Guna x Vidzemes Skaistule. Sugar up to Brix 24. labrusca taste. Very productive. Ripens in August-early September. Wood hardening good.



# A.Fazekash: 'Marite'

Smugljanka x Korinka Russkaja. Brix 20. Seedless, with seeds in some berries. High quality, vinifera like taste. Short bunches. Big strong frost resistant leaves. Ripens in August-early September.



# A.Fazekash: 'Inga'

Smugljanka x Dvuglavij. Very productive, high juice content. Pure taste. Brix 16 at the end of August. Ripens in the middle of September.



# A.Fazekash: 'Zanda'

(Smuglanka x Dvuglavij + Vidzemes Skaistule + *V.riparia*)  
Brix 15 at the end of August. Good sized clusters and berries.  
Productive (too much). Ripens in the middle of September.



**A.Fazekash: Hybrid 4-5-5** (Muskat Voskovej x Zilga + Hasanskij Sladkij + Vidzemes Skaistule).

Specific riesling type taste with labrusca tones. Brix 18. Wine grape?



# New hybrids of A.Fazekash

A.Fazekash's hybrids growing at Pure Experimental Station (more than 500) are under supervision of Inese Drudze. First crop of hybrids have been shown on grape exhibition 2009. Many selections have good sugar level, and their wine potential and production characteristics should be evaluated in future.
